





Philanthropic Opportunities: Women Scholarships



Women empowerment initiatives such as the Women Scholarships program are vital in the humanitarian sector to attain the

broader goals of gender equality, inclusivity, and sustainable development.

Such programs are crucial to provide a more inclusive, resilient, and sustainable response to crises, addressing the unique challenges faced by women and promoting gender equality as a fundamental human right.

The humanitarian sector is made up of 43% women. However, women are still under-represented among senior management in the sector due to myriad factors including long-standing gender norms. Scholarship funding for women will promote greater inclusivity among course participants and help break down the barriers to their professional advancement.

The Women Scholarships program will enable the CHL to be a catalyst for change



by promoting equal opportunities, access to resources, and the removal of barriers that hinder women's participation and advancement.
